

McIntosh County Board of Commissioners
Special Called Emergency Meeting Minutes
September 28, 2022
11:00am

An emergency special called meeting of the McIntosh County Board of Commissioners was held on Wednesday, September 28, 2022 at 11:00am at the McIntosh County EOC building.

A. INVOCATION AND PLEDGE

Invocation was given by Commissioner Lotson and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Chairman Stevens.

B. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chairman Stevens welcomed everyone in attendance and called the meeting to order at 11:00am.

C. ROLL CALL

Present: David Stevens, Chairman; Kate Karwacki, Vice-Chairman; and Roger Lotson, Commissioner. Also in attendance were County Manager Patrick Zoucks, Deputy County Manager Shawn Jordan, County Attorney Adam S. Poppell III, Ty Poppell, EMA Director, County Clerk Sherrell Davis, and Kathleen Russell with the Darien News.

D. APPROVE AGENDA

Motion made by Commissioner Lotson, seconded by Commissioner Karwacki to approve the September 28, 2022 agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

E. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution 2022-21 “Declaring a Local State of Emergency for Hurricane Ian”

County Manager Zoucks explained the resolution stating it was to declare a local state of emergency for Hurricane Ian. He stated that the time frame included in the resolution was from September 28, 2022 thru October 3, 2022.

Commissioner Lotson asked what the projected potential damages on Sapelo were? Ty Poppell, EMA Director said that the storm’s description was compared to Irma, but had since been downgraded. The island could possibly experience strong winds only.

Commissioner Lotson asked were there any other areas in the county that we may need to be concerned about? County Manager Zoucks responded that anything they knew about earlier is fixed or is getting fixed. Chairman said that they were putting equipment in various places around the county.

Motion made by Commissioner Lotson, seconded by Commissioner Karwacki to adopt Resolution 2022-21 declaring a local state of emergency for Hurricane Ian. Motion carried 3-0 unanimously.

F. ADJOURNMENT


With no further business Chairman Stevens adjourned the meeting at 11:04am
